This document provides a set of thematic maps on the **religion** data by estate and settlement in Milton Keynes from 2011 Census data.

Methodology

These maps were created by the Research and Intelligence team at Milton Keynes Council based on 2011 Census data published by the Office for National Statistics.

The 2011 Census data was not released at estate level. The Research and Intelligence team at Milton Keynes Council therefore added together Output Area (the smallest census geography) data to provide an estimate at estate level. As Output Areas (OAs) boundaries and estate boundaries do not always match, the data for OAs is weighted to estates. The data in the maps should therefore be seen as estimates based on 2011 Census data rather than actual figures. 




Map 1 % Christian



Rural Areas tend to have the highest percentage of residents reporting being Christian. Clifton Reynes (73.0%) and Stoke Goldington (71.3%) have the highest percentage of Christian residents. Fullers Slade (40.9%), Central Milton Keynes (41.3%) and Redhouse Park (41.7%) have the lowest percentage.




Buddhists appear in small proportions across the borough. Newton Blossomville has the highest proportion with just 2.0%.




Estates with the highest percentage of Hindu residents tend to be concentrated around the city centre and the west of the city. Oldbrook (10.7%), Oakhill (10.4%) and Central Milton Keynes (10.2%) have the highest percentage of Hindu residents.

Water Eaton



Jewish residents appear in small proportions across Milton Keynes. Tyringham & Filgrave has the highest proportion with just 1.6%.






Fishermead has the highest percentage of Muslim residents, accounting for 17.4% of all residents. Other estates with high percentages include Granby (16.4%), Stacey Bushes (15.2%), Central Bletchley (14.1%) and Wolverton (13.3%).

Sikh residents appear in small proportions across the borough. Walton Park has the highest proportion with just 3.6%.



Estates with the highest proportion of residents stating they had no religion include Redhouse Park (47.6%), Fullers Slade (43.9%), Oakridge Park (41.5%) and New Bradwell (40.9%).
