In May 2016 unemployment (claimant count) went down to 2,140 claimants in Milton Keynes (1.3%) of the working age population from 2,231 (1.3%) in April 2016, a decrease of 91 claimants.

Population Estimates Mid-year 2015

ONS has published the population estimates mid-year 2015 in Local Authorities level. Milton Keynes population in 2015 increased 1% compared to the previous vear (2014→259,245: $2015 \rightarrow 261,762$). This condition is similar to England (1% increased) in 2015.
