1. Executive Summary

Population

- The population of Newport Pagnell North in 2011 was 7,390.
- The Newport Pagnell North population size declined slightly between 2001 and 2011. The population decreased by 55 people (0.7%) to 7,390.
- Newport Pagnell North had an older profile than the Milton Keynes average.
 The average age in Newport Pagnell North was 42 compared with 35 for Milton Keynes.
- 17.0% of the population were aged under 15 compared with 21% in Milton Keynes. 17.0% of the population were aged 65+ compared with 11.1% in Milton Keynes.
- The highest growth occurred in the 60-64 age groups. The number of people aged 60-64 grew by 115% from 260 people in 2001 to 570 people in 2011.
- 8.2% of the Newport Pagnell North population were from a black and minority ethnic group. This compares to 6.1% in 2001 and 26.1% for Milton Keynes as a whole.
- The black and minority ethnic group that grew the most between 2001 and 2011 was White Other (1.3% of the population in 2001 to 2.8% in 2011).
- Just 7.5% of the population in Newport Pagnell North were born outside of the UK. This is significantly lower than Milton Keynes (18.5%).

Health

- 570 residents said their day to day activities were limited a lot because of health issues. This is 7.7% of the population compared with 6.4% for Milton Keynes.
- 790 residents in Newport Pagnell North provided some unpaid care a week.
 This is 10.7% of the population compared with 8.8% in Milton Keynes as a whole

Housing

- Newport Pagnell North had a smaller percentage of households with dependent children than Milton Keynes (30.5% compared to 35.0%).
- The percentage of one person households was smaller in Newport Pagnell North (22.0%) than in Milton Keynes as a whole (25.9%).
- Newport Pagnell North had the same average household size (2.5) as Milton Keynes as a whole.
- A smaller percentage of dwellings in the ward (5.8%) were flats compared with Milton Keynes (16.2%).

- A growing percentage of dwellings in Newport Pagnell North were flats. 4.7% of dwellings in the ward were flats in 2001, this compares to 5.8% in 2011.
- Newport Pagnell North had a significantly higher percentage of owner occupied households and a smaller percentage living in social and private rented accommodation than Milton Keynes as a whole.
- The percentage of households living in private rented accommodation in Newport Pagnell North increased from 6.3% in 2001 to 12.0% in 2011.

Transport

 There were 250 more cars or vans in Newport Pagnell North households in 2011 compared with 2001. This is a 6.0% increase compared to the population decline of 0.7%.

Education


- Levels of qualifications in Newport Pagnell North were lower than the Milton Keynes average. 23.3% had a degree or higher compared with 28.2% in Milton Keynes. 19.2% had no qualifications compared with 18.0%.
- Levels of qualifications increased considerably between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 16.2% of residents aged 16+ had a degree or higher qualification by 2011 this had increased to 23.3%.

Economic

- A higher percentage (70.0%) of Newport Pagnell North residents aged 16-74 were in employment compared with Milton Keynes (68%).
- There was a fall from 53.5% to 47.0% between 2001 and 2011 in the percentage of the 16-74 year old population in Newport Pagnell North working as full time employees.
- 9.6% of Newport Pagnell North residents in employment were employed in the manufacturing sector compared with 8.0% in Milton Keynes as a whole. The wholesale and retail trade industrial sector was the largest employer of Newport Pagnell North residents.
- Residents in Newport Pagnell North were more likely to be classified in intermediate socio-economic categories than Milton Keynes as a whole.

2. Introduction

3. Population Size and Age Structure

The Newport Pagnell North population size declined slightly between 2001 and 2011. The population decreased by 55 people (0.7%) to 7,390.

In 2011 the population of Newport Pagnell North was 7,390. Table 1 outlines that the population decreased in size between 2001 and 2011. Newport Pagnell North decreased by 55 people, this is an decrease of 0.7% compared with a 17% increase for Milton Keynes as a whole.

Newport Pagnell North had an older profile than the Milton Keynes average. The average age in Newport Pagnell North was 42 compared with 35 for Milton Keynes.

Table 2 shows the age structure of Newport Pagnell North compared with Milton Keynes. It outlines that the ward had a high percentage in the older age groups. In Newport Pagnell North in 2011 17.0% of the population were aged under 15 compared with 21% in Milton Keynes. 17.0% of the population were aged 65+ compared with 11.1% in Milton Keynes.



The highest growth rate between 2001 and 2011 in Newport Pagnell North occurred in the 60-64 year old age group.

Graph 2 shows the change in age structure between 2001 and 2011. It outlines that the highest growth occurred in the 60-64 age groups. The number of people aged 60-64 grew by 115.2% from 260 people in 2001 to 570 people in 2011.

The number of people aged 5-19 decreased by 350 people (-21.5%) in Newport Pagnell North between 2001 and 2011.

4. Ethnicity

Just 8.2% of the population in Newport Pagnell North were from a black and minority ethnic group compared with 26.1% in Milton Keynes.

Table 3 shows the number of people in each ethnic group in Newport Pagnell North compared with Milton Keynes. It outlines that Newport Pagnell North had a smaller percentage in each ethnic group compared with Milton Keynes.

The largest black and minority ethnic group in Newport Pagnell North was White Other. 210 people in Newport Pagnell North classified themselves as White Other this is 2.8% of the population, significantly lower than the Milton Keynes figure of 5.1%.

100 people in Newport Pagnell North classified themselves as Mixed. This is 1.4% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes average of 3.3%. Other ethnic groups appear in small proportions.

The population is becoming more ethnically diverse. In 2001 6.1% of the population were from a black and minority ethnic group compared with 8.2% in 2011.

Graph 3 outlines that the Other: White population had the highest growth in Newport Pagnell North between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 it accounted for 1.3% of the population by 2011 they accounted for 2.8% of the population, this is an increase from 100 people to 210.

The percentage of the Newport Pagnell North population that were White British declined from 93.9% to 91.8% between 2001 and 2011.

5. Country of Birth

Just 7.5% of the population in Newport Pagnell North were born outside of the UK. This is the significantly lower than Milton Keynes (18.5%).

7.5% of the population in Newport Pagnell North were born outside of the UK, this is a total of 555 people. This is the third lowest percentage of all wards in Milton Keynes. Table 4 shows the country of birth for Newport Pagnell North residents compared with Milton Keynes.

1.0% of the Newport Pagnell North population were born in Ireland and 1.7% were born in EU member states as at March 2001. 60 people where born in 2001-2011 EU accession countries; this is 0.8% of the population, lower than Milton Keynes as a whole (2.5%). 300 people (4.0%) were born outside of the EU, significantly lower than the Milton Keynes figure of 13.0%.

The number of Newport Pagnell North residents born outside of the UK increased from 430 people to 555 between 2001 and 2011.

Just 80 people living in Newport Pagnell North had been living in the UK for less than five years.

1.1% of the total Newport Pagnell North population had lived in the UK for less than five years, significantly lower than Milton Keynes as a whole (5.4%).

6. Household Language

1.9% of households in Newport Pagnell North had no adult who had English as their main language compared with 6.4% in Milton Keynes.

96.1% of households in Newport Pagnell North had all adults in the households with English as their first language and 98.1% had at least one adult with English as their first language.

7. Religion

60.3% of the Newport Pagnell North population stated they were Christian, 0.5% Muslim and 0.4% Hindu. 31.4% of the population in Newport Pagnell North stated they had no religion.


Table 7 shows the number of people in each religious group in Newport Pagnell North compared with Milton Keynes. It outlines that the largest religious group in Milton Keynes was Christian which accounted for 60.3% of the population, this is a higher percentage than Milton Keynes as a whole (52.8%).

Religions other than Christian were in small proportions in Newport Pagnell North. Muslim was the second largest religion with just 40 people (0.5%).

Graph 4 outlines the changes in religion in Newport Pagnell North between 2001 and 2011. It shows that there was a decline in the percentage of the population who stated they were Christian (73.7% to 60.3%) and an increase in the percentage who stated they had no religion (18.1% to 31.4%). There had been no major change in the other religions.

8. Health

7.7% of residents in Newport Pagnell North said their day to day activities were limited a lot because of health issues. This compares to 6.4% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

The 2011 Census asked two questions on the health of residents. Both questions highlight that a larger percentage of the population in Newport Pagnell North felt that they had health issues when compared to Milton Keynes.

1. Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?

570 people stated their day-today activities were limited a lot due to health; this is 7.7% of population compared with 6.4% in Milton Keynes. In total 16.8% of residents in Newport Pagnell North stated they were limited a lot or a little. This compares to 13.9% in Milton Keynes.

2. How is your health in general?

325 respondents in Newport Pagnell North felt their general health was bad or very bad. This is 4.4% of the population compared with 4.1% of the Milton Keynes population. 83.1% of residents in the ward felt they had good or very good health compared with 85.1% in Milton Keynes.

The 2011 Census questions on health were different to the 2001 Census and therefore can not be directly compared.

Health status is very strongly correlated to age. Residents in the older age groups tend to be less healthy than younger age groups. Therefore to make robust comparisons between areas health by age is needed.

9. Carers

790 residents in Newport Pagnell North provided some unpaid care a week. This is 10.7% of the population compared with 8.8% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

The 2011 Census asked respondents if they provided some unpaid care each week to others either because of a long term disability or old age. The results show that around 790 people in Newport Pagnell North provided some unpaid care. This is 10.7% of the population, larger than the Milton Keynes figure of 8.8%.

Table 10 shows the number of hours of unpaid care residents undertook each week. It outlines that around 220 people undertook more than 20 hours of unpaid care each week with 135 of those undertaking more than 50 hours.



The number of Newport Pagnell North residents providing unpaid care increased by 150 people (24%) between 2001 and 2011.

The number of Newport Pagnell North residents providing unpaid care grew from 640 in 2001 to 790 in 2011. As a percentage of the Milton Keynes population it increased from 8.6% in 2001 to 10.7% in 2011.

Graph 5 outlines that those that were providing unpaid care were doings so with greater hours. 3.0% of the population provided unpaid care for 20 or more hours a week compared with 2.1% in 2001.

10. Living Arrangements

Newport Pagnell North had a higher percentage of people living as a couple than Milton Keynes as a whole.

3,900 residents aged 16 and over in Newport Pagnell North were living as a couple this is 65.9% and compares to 60.4% for Milton Keynes as a whole. 1,185 (20%) residents were single (never married) whilst 5.9% were widowed.

11. Household Composition

Newport Pagnell North had a lower percentage of households with dependent children than Milton Keynes as a whole.

There were 2,925 households in Newport Pagnell North in 2011. 330 (11.3%) of these households were one person pensioner household, this compares to 8.7% for Milton Keynes as a whole. In total 22.0% of households in the ward were one person households compared with 25.9% for Milton Keynes.

In total 890 (30.5%) households in Newport Pagnell North had dependent children this compares to 35.0% in Milton Keynes.

180 households, or 6.2%, in Newport Pagnell North were lone parent households with dependent children. This compares to 8.3% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

The percentage of households with dependent children in Newport Pagnell North declined from 35.4% in 2001 to 30.5% in 2011.

Table 13 outlines how household composition changed between 2001 and 2011. The number of households with dependent children fell slightly from 1,000 to 890; this is a fall from 35.4% of households to 30.5%.

12. Rooms and Bedrooms

Newport Pagnell North had the same average household size (2.5) as Milton Keynes as a whole.

The Newport Pagnell average household size of 2.3 was the 8th highest of all 23 wards in Milton Keynes. There was a decrease in the average household size in the ward between 2001 and 2011 from 2.6 in 2001 to 2.5 in 2011.

Newport Pagnell North had a larger number of rooms per household compared with Milton Keynes as a whole. There was an average of 3 bedrooms per household and 5.8 rooms per household in Newport Pagnell North.

60 households in Newport Pagnell North lived in over occupied accommodation.

The 2011 Census also estimates the number of households with a high occupancy rating. An occupancy rating of -1 implies that a household had one less room/bedroom than required. Table 15 shows that Newport Pagnell North had around 60 households (2.2%) which were over occupied in terms of bedrooms. This is lower than the Milton Keynes figure of 5.1%.

Over occupancy in terms of rooms decreased between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 125 (4.4%) households had an occupancy rating of -1 or less, in 2011 it had fallen to 110 (3.7%).

13. Accommodation Type

A smaller percentage of dwellings were classified as flats in Newport Pagnell North than Milton Keynes as a whole.

There were 2,990 dwellings in Newport Pagnell North in 2011. The 2011 Census asked residents what type of dwelling they lived in. A smaller percentage of dwellings in the ward (5.8%) were flats compared with Milton Keynes (16.2%).

Newport Pagnell North had a larger percentage of semi-detached houses/bungalows than Milton Keynes as a whole (44.0% compared to 28.1%).


A growing percentage of dwellings in Newport Pagnell North were flats. 4.7% of dwellings in the ward were flats in 2001, this compares to 5.8% in 2011.

Overall the number of dwellings in Newport Pagnell North grew from 2,880 in 2001 to 2,990 in 2011. This is an increase of 110 dwellings or 3.9%.

The number of flats in Newport Pagnell North grew from 140 in 2001 to 170 in 2011. Graph 6 outlines that the percentage of dwelling which were flats increased from 4.7% in 2001 to 5.8% in 2011; this is a trend which is observed nationally.

The number of houses/bungalows in Milton Keynes increased from 2,730 in 2001 to 2,815 in 2011. However they declined in percentage from 95.0% of all dwellings to 94.2%.

14. Tenure

Newport Pagnell North had a significantly higher percentage of owner occupied households and a smaller percentage living in social and private rented accommodation than Milton Keynes as a whole.

79.3% of households in Newport Pagnell North were owner occupied; this is significantly higher than the figure for Milton Keynes as a whole of 57.7%.

A smaller percentage of households were living in the council rented accommodation in Newport Pagnell North than Milton Keynes. 180 households (6.3%) lived in council rented accommodation compared to 11.0% in Milton Keynes.

Newport Pagnell also had a lower percentage of households in other social rented accommodation than Milton Keynes. There were just 50 households in social rented housing other than from the council accounting for 1.6% of households compared with 7.1% in Milton Keynes. 350 households were in private rented accommodation (including living rent free); this is 12.0% of households.



The percentage of households living in private rented accommodation in Newport Pagnell North increased from 6.3% in 2001 to 12.0% in 2011.

In 2001 180 households in Newport Pagnell North were living in private rented accommodation by 2011 it had increased to 350. It increased from 6.3% of all households in 2001 to 12.0% in 2011.

There was a large decrease in the percentage of households living in owner occupied properties in Newport Pagnell North from 84.7% in 2001 to 79.3% in 2011.

There were 140 residents of communal establishments in Newport Pagnell North Ward.

There were 3 communal establishments in the ward with 140 residents. The majority (91.2%) of the residents live within care home with nursing establishments.

16. Car or Van Availability

There were 250 more cars or vans in Newport Pagnell North in 2011 compared with 2001, this is an increase of 6.0%.


In 2011 there were 4,370 cars or vans in households in Newport Pagnell North compared with 4,125 in 2001. 370 households in the ward had no car or van. This is 12.5% of all households, significantly lower than Milton Keynes (18.9%).

18. Qualifications and Students

Levels of qualifications in Newport Pagnell North were lower than the Milton Keynes average. 23.3% had a degree and higher compared with 28.2% in Milton Keynes. 19.2% had no qualifications compared with 18.0%.

Table 20 shows the highest level of qualifications for residents aged 16+. It outlines that roughly 1,170 people aged 16+ in Newport Pagnell North had no qualifications. This is 19.2% of the population and is higher than the Milton Keynes average of 18.0%.

1,410 people aged 16+ in the ward had a degree or higher qualification. This is 23.3% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes average of 28.2%.

Newport Pagnell North had the highest percentage of apprenticeships of all wards in Milton Keynes. 330 people in the ward had an apprenticeship as the highest level of qualification this is 5.4% of the population.



Levels of qualifications in Newport Pagnell North increased significantly between 2001 and 2011.

Graph 9 outlines how levels of qualifications changed between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 16.2% of residents aged 16+ had a degree or higher, by 2011 this had increased to 23.3%. In 2001 23.7% of the population had no qualifications by 2011 this had decreased to 19.2%.

Newport Pagnell North had a smaller percentage of students aged 18+ than Milton Keynes.

Table 21 shows that there were 160 people aged 18 and over in full time education resident in the ward. This is 2.7% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes average of 3.5%.

19. Economic Activity

A higher percentage (70.0%) of Newport Pagnell North residents aged 16-74 were in employment compared with Milton Keynes (68%).

Table 22 outlines that the population aged 16-74 can be broken down into two broad categories:

1. Economically Active: People that were in work or looking and available for work.

4,120 people in the Newport Pagnell North were economically active. This is 76.2% of the 16-74 year old population, similar to the Milton Keynes figure of 75.9%. Newport Pagnell North had a higher employment than Milton Keynes as a whole and a smaller unemployment rate. 3,785 residents in the ward were in employment, this is 70.0% of the 16-74 year old population compared with 68.0% for Milton Keynes.

There were 170 unemployed people in Newport Pagnell North which accounted for 3.1% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes rate of 4.8%.

2. Economically Inactive: People that were not in work and were not looking and available for work.

Newport Pagnell North had a similar economic activity rate to Milton Keynes. 23.8% of the ward's 16-74 population were economically inactive compared with 24.1% in Milton Keynes as a whole. However a large percentage of the 16-74 year old population were retired (14.6% compared with 10.3% for Milton Keynes).

A smaller percentage of the 16-74 year old population were looking after home or family (2.9% in Newport Pagnell North, 4.6% in Milton Keynes). Also a smaller percentage were long-term sick or disabled, students not in or looking for work or economically inactive for other.



There was a fall in the percentage of the 16-74 year old population in Newport Pagnell North working as full time employees.

Graph 10 outlines that the percentage of the 16-74 population employed as full time employees decreased from 53.3% in 2001 to 47.0% in 2011. However, there was an increase in the percentage of people in part time employment and self employment which offsets the decrease to some degree. Overall employment declined from 73.5% to 70.0%. This is a trend experienced nationally.

The percentage of people who were unemployed increased from 2.0% to 3.1%, whilst the percentage of people who were retired also increased between 2001 and 2011.

Economic activity is strongly correlated to age. Middle aged people tend to be more economically active than younger people (who may be students) and older people (who were more likely to be retired etc). Therefore to make robust comparisons between areas economic activity by age is needed.

20. Hours Worked

Three quarters of Newport Pagnell North residents in employment worked full time hours whilst a quarter worked part time.


The 2011 Census asked those in employment how many hours they worked a week. Table 23 outlines that in total 1,010 the ward's residents worked part time hours this is 25.7%.

21. Industry

9.6% of Newport Pagnell North residents in employment were employed in the manufacturing sector compared with 8.0% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

3,200 Newport Pagnell North residents were employed in the service sector. This is 81.8% of employment compared with 85.3% in Milton Keynes as a whole. 375 Newport Pagnell North residents were employed in the manufacturing sector; this is 9.6% of those in employment. A larger percentage of residents were employed in 'other' industries such as construction in the ward compared with Milton Keynes.

The wholesale and retail trade industrial sector was the largest employer of Newport Pagnell North residents.

Table 24 provides more detail on the industry of employment in Newport Pagnell North and Milton Keynes. It shows that the wholesale and retail trade was the largest employer of residents in the ward. 800 residents were employed in this sector; this is 20.5% of people in employment compared with 20.6% in Milton

Keynes. Education, health and social work and public administration, defence and compulsory social security employs 980 people (25.0%).

The manufacturing and construction sectors were larger in Newport Pagnell North than Milton Keynes as a whole. The transport and storage, professional, scientific and technical activities and information and communication were in smaller proportions compared with Milton Keynes.

22. Occupation

11.0% of residents in the ward were employed in manager, director and senior official occupations and 10.4% in elementary occupations.

Roughly the same percentage of employees were employed in the managerial occupations in Newport Pagnell North compared with Milton Keynes as a whole. 410 residents were employed in elementary occupations. This is 10.4% of those in employment and is lower than the Milton Keynes average of 12.3%.

A smaller percentage of people in employment in Newport Pagnell were employed in professional and elementary occupations than Milton Keynes as a whole. Larger proportions were employed in administrative and secretarial occupations, skilled trades occupations, and caring, leisure and other service occupations.



The largest increase in employment between 2001 and 2011 in Newport Pagnell North occurred in professional occupations the largest decrease occurred in managers, directors and senior officials.

Graph 12 outlines that the largest increase in employment between 2001 and 2011 in Newport Pagnell North occurred in professional occupations. 10.0% of those in employment in 2001 were employed in professional occupations by 2011 this increased to 14.1%. The largest decrease occurred in managers, directors and senior officials from 15.0% to 11.0%.

23. National Statistics – Socio-Economic Classification

Residents in Newport Pagnell North were more likely to be classified in intermediate socio-economic categories than Milton Keynes as a whole.

550 residents aged 16-74 in the ward were in the higher managerial and professional category. This is 10.1% of the population compared with 12.2% in Milton Keynes. Newport Pagnell North also had a higher percentage of people in the intermediate occupations, lower supervisory and technical occupations and the small employers and own account workers categories.

Newport Pagnell North had a smaller percentage of residents in the routine occupations, never worked and long-term unemployed and higher managerial and professional occupations than Milton Keynes as a whole.
