Milton Keynes Ethnicity of School Age Children & Young People – 2012

Overall in Milton Keynes, Black and Minority Ethnic groups* represent 34.1% of Pupils. This compares with the 2005 findings of 20.7%.

36.4% of pupils of primary school age come from minority ethnic groups compared to 29.3% of those of secondary school age. 32.7% of those in sixth form education are in black and minority ethnic groups.

The Black African Group is the largest minority ethnic group accounting for 9.2% of pupils. This is followed by the Mixed (5.9%) and White Other groups (4.4%).


Black Caribbean pupils form just 0.9% of the Milton Keynes pupil population. Black Other pupils now account for 1.7%.

Pakistani pupils now make up the largest population in the Asian ethnic group with 1,171 pupils forming 2.8% of the pupil population in Milton Keynes. Indians make up 2.7% of the pupil population and Bangladeshis 1.5%.

Chinese pupils form just 0.6% of the Milton Keynes pupil population.

The graph above outlines the change in the proportions of pupils recorded in each black and minority ethnic group between 2005 and 2012. Black African had the largest increase in numbers (2,366 extra pupils) this is an increase of 166%. Asian Other Group has the highest growth rate of 234% whilst Black Other (168%) also had a high growth rate. White Irish (-23%) Chinese (-14%) and White UK (-6%) all experienced a decline.

The following tables show the 15 estates with the highest proportion for the main black and minority ethnic groups. For confidentiality reasons the figures exclude estates with less than four members of the minority ethnic group or less than 10 pupils in total.

Black African pupils are quite well spread in Milton Keynes, appearing in 85 of the 117 estates and settlements in Milton Keynes. They account for almost a third of pupils in Conniburrow and Campbell Park and over a quarter of pupils in Fishermead and Ashland. There is also a high proportion in Granby, although in small numbers.

Black Caribbean's form only 0.9% of the overall pupil population Milton Keynes yet in percentage terms they are quite significant in Leadenhall and Broughton Gate although only relatively small numbers are involved. The highest number of Black Caribbean pupils is in West Bletchley with 21. They appear in 69 of Milton Keynes' estates and settlements.

Estates with the highest proportion of the Black Other group include Fishermead, Broughton and Atterbury, and Wolverton Mill. They appear in 74 estates and settlements.

Bangladeshi pupils form a highly significant part of Central Bletchley's pupil make-up, accounting for over a quarter of all pupils. They are also in large numbers (173) in Water Eaton. They are, however, the least spread of BME groups in Milton Keynes, appearing only in small numbers in areas other than Central Bletchley and Water Eaton, and in only 50 of Milton Keynes 117 estates and settlements. Only 10 estates have more than 10 Bangladeshi pupils, 4 of which are outside the Bletchley area.

Asian Other pupils appear in 78 estates in Milton Keynes, there are relatively high proportions in Springfield, Oldbrook, Downs Barn, Campbell Park and Eaglestone.

Mixed ethnicity pupils are spread around Milton Keynes, appearing in 98 of the estates and settlements, but this is because it is a combined group of mixed ethnicities and may not be a homogenous group.
