• In February 2015 unemployment (claimant count) went up to 3,000 claimants in Milton Keynes (1.8% of the working age population) from 2,817 (1.7%) in January 2015, an increase of 183 claimants.

New population projections for Milton Keynes are now on the MKi Observatory. The population projections include the following:

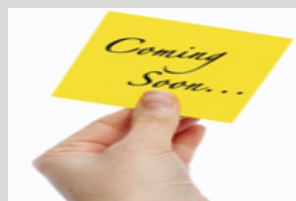
