Newport Pagnell South Ward 2011 Census Profile



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1. Executive Summary

Population

- The population of Newport Pagnell South in 2011 was 7,730.
- Newport Pagnell had a relatively small population growth rate. The population grew by 430 people between 2001 and 2011. This is a 6% increase, the 9th smallest growth rate of all wards in Milton Keynes.
- Newport Pagnell South had an older age profile than Milton Keynes as a whole. It had a smaller percentage of the population in the younger age groups; 16.9% were aged under 15 compared with 21.0% in Milton Keynes.
- The highest growth rate between 2001 and 2011 occurred in the 60-74 year old age groups, growing by 71%. In contrast the number of people aged 5-19 decreased by 240 people (-15.5%).
- 9.4% of the Newport Pagnell South population were from a black and minority ethnic group. This compares to 6.9% in 2001 and 26.1% for Milton Keynes as a whole.
- The black and minority ethnic groups that grew the most between 2001 and 2011 were White Other (1.9% of the population in 2001 to 3.2% in 2011) and Mixed (1.2% of the population in 2001 to 1.7% in 2011).
- Just 7.8% of the population in Newport Pagnell South were born outside of the UK. This is significantly lower than Milton Keynes (18.5%).

Health

- 450 residents said their day to day activities were limited a lot because of health issues. This is 5.8% of the population compared with 6.4% for Milton Keynes.
- 700 residents in Newport Pagnell South provided some unpaid care a week. This is 9.1% of the population compared with 8.8% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

Housing

- Newport Pagnell South had a smaller percentage of households with dependent children than Milton Keynes (29.9% compared to 35.0%).
- The percentage of one person households is larger in Newport Pagnell South (27.9%) than in Milton Keynes as a whole (25.9%).
- Newport Pagnell South had a small average household size. It had an average of 2.3 people per household compared with 2.5 in Milton Keynes.
- A growing percentage of dwellings in Newport Pagnell South were flats. In 2001 just 8.9% of dwellings in the ward were flats, by 2011 this had increased to 12.2%. However, this is still below the percentage for Milton Keynes as a whole (16.2%).

- Newport Pagnell South had a significantly higher percentage of owner occupied households and a smaller percentage living in social rented accommodation than Milton Keynes as a whole.
- The percentage of households living in private rented accommodation in Newport Pagnell South increased from 9.2% in 2001 to 18.3% in 2011.

Transport

- There were 560 more cars or vans in Newport Pagnell South households in 2011 compared with 2001. This is a 13.9% increase compared to the population growth of 6%.

Education

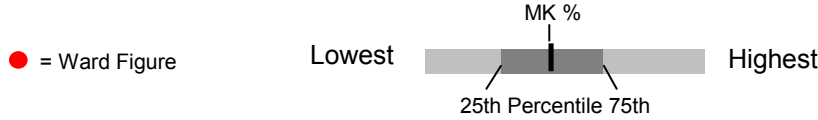
- Levels of qualifications in Newport Pagnell South were higher than the Milton Keynes average. 30.2% had a degree or higher compared with 28.2% in Milton Keynes. 15.4% had no qualifications compared with 18.0% in Milton Keynes.
- In addition to qualifications being higher than Milton Keynes, levels of qualifications increased considerably between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 19.1% of residents aged 16+ had a degree or higher qualification, by 2011 this had increased to 30.2%.

Economic

- A higher percentage (73.2%) of Newport Pagnell South residents aged 16-74 were in employment compared with Milton Keynes (68%).
- There was a fall from 55% to 49.2% between 2001 and 2011 in the percentage of the 16-74 year old population in Newport Pagnell South working as full time employees.
- 83.6% of Newport Pagnell South residents in employment were employed in the service sector compared with 85.3% in Milton Keynes as a whole. The wholesale and retail trade industrial sector was the largest employer of Newport Pagnell South residents.
- Residents in Newport Pagnell South were more likely to be classified in managerial and intermediate socio-economic categories than Milton Keynes as a whole.

2. Introduction

This document provides a profile of Newport Pagnell South Ward from data released via the 2011 Census. The profile includes data for the ward and comparisons to Milton Keynes and to the 2001 Census figures.

3. Population Size and Age Structure

Newport Pagnell South had a low population growth rate when compared with Milton Keynes as a whole. The population increased by 430 people (6%) to 7,730 between 2001 and 2011.

In 2011 the population of Newport Pagnell South was 7,730. Table 1 outlines that the population growth in Newport Pagnell South between 2001 and 2011 was significantly lower than for Milton Keynes as a whole. Newport Pagnell South grew by 430 people, this is an increase of 6% compared with 17% for Milton Keynes. Out of the 23 wards in Milton Keynes it had the 9th smallest population growth between 2001 and 2011.

Newport Pagnell South had an older profile than the Milton Keynes average. The average age in Newport Pagnell South was 39 compared with 35 for Milton Keynes.

Table 2 shows the age structure of Newport Pagnell South compared with Milton Keynes. It outlines that the ward had a high percentage in the older age groups. In Newport Pagnell South in 2011 16.9% of the population were aged under 15 compared with 21% in Milton Keynes. 13.3% of the population were aged 65+ compared with 11.1% in Milton Keynes.

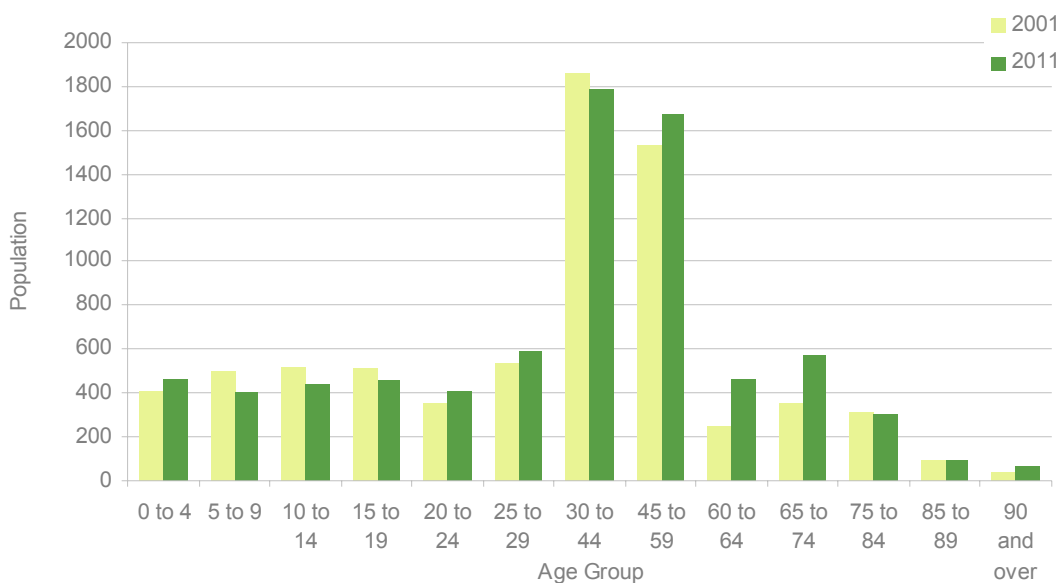

The highest growth rate between 2001 and 2011 in Newport Pagnell South occurred in the 60-74 year old age group.

Graph 2 shows the change in age structure between 2001 and 2011. It outlines that the highest growth occurred in the 60-74 and 90 age groups. The number of people aged 60-74 grew by 71% from 610 people in 2001 to 1,040 people in 2011.

The number of people aged 5-19 decreased by 240 people (15.5%) in Newport Pagnell South between 2001 and 2011.

4. Ethnicity

9.4% of the population in Newport Pagnell South were from a black and minority ethnic group compared with 26.1% in Milton Keynes.

Table 3 shows the number of people in each ethnic group in Newport Pagnell South compared with Milton Keynes. It outlines that Newport Pagnell South had a smaller percentage in each ethnic group compared with Milton Keynes.

The largest black and minority ethnic group in Newport Pagnell South was White Other. 250 people in Newport Pagnell South classified themselves as White Other this is 3.2% of the population, significantly lower than the Milton Keynes figure of 5.1%.

130 people in Newport Pagnell South classified themselves as Mixed. This is 1.7% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes average of 3.3%. Other ethnic groups appear in small proportions.

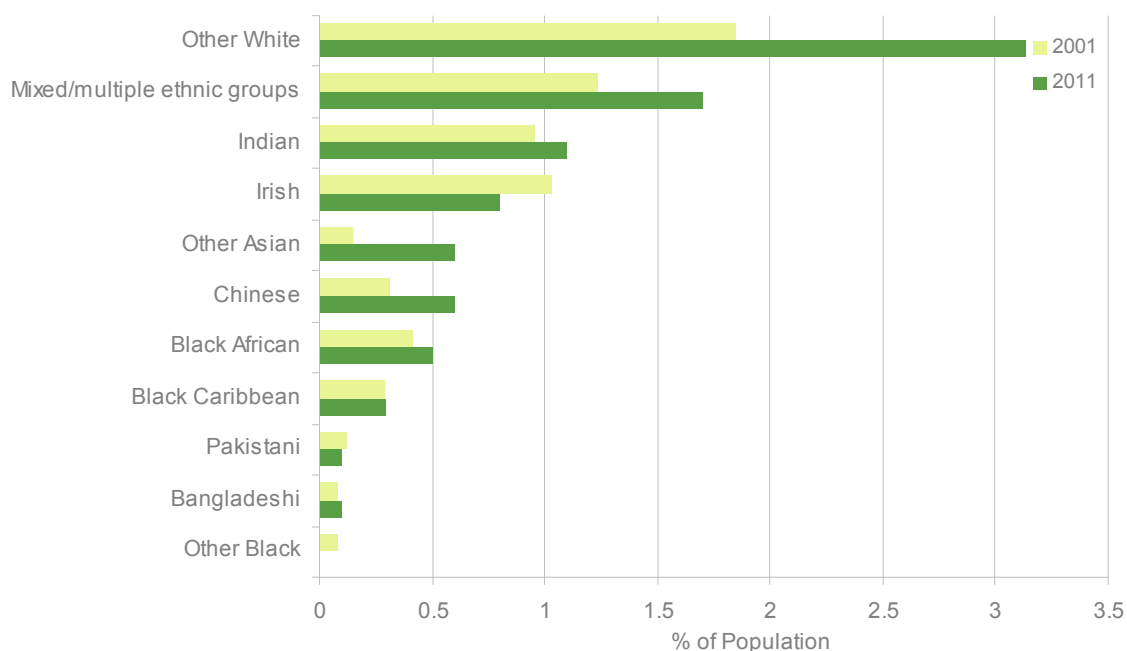

The population is becoming more ethnically diverse. In 2001 6.9% of the population were from a black and minority ethnic group compared with 9.4% in 2011.

Graph 3 outlines that the White Other population had the highest growth in Newport Pagnell South between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 it accounted for 1.9% of the population by 2011 it accounted for 3.2% of the population, this is an increase from 135 people to 250.

The percentage of the Newport Pagnell South population that were White British declined from 93.1% to 90.6% between 2001 and 2011.

5. Country of Birth

Just 7.8% of the population in Newport Pagnell South were born outside of the UK. This is significantly lower than Milton Keynes (18.5%).

7.8% of the population in Newport Pagnell South were born outside of the UK, this is a total of 600 people. Table 4 shows the country of birth for Newport Pagnell South residents compared with Milton Keynes.

0.6% of the Newport Pagnell South population were born in Ireland and 1.5% were born in EU member states as at March 2001. 110 people were born in 2001-2011 EU accession countries; this is 1.4% of the population, lower than Milton Keynes as a whole (2.5%). 330 people (4.3%) were born outside of the EU, significantly lower than the Milton Keynes figure of 13.0%.

The number of Newport Pagnell South residents born outside of the UK increased from 450 people to 600 between 2001 and 2011.

Just 130 people living in Newport Pagnell South had been living in the UK for less than five years.

1.7% of the total Newport Pagnell South population had lived in the UK for less than five years, significantly lower than Milton Keynes as a whole (5.4%).

6. Household Language

2.3% of households in Newport Pagnell South had no adult who had English as their main language compared with 6.4% in Milton Keynes.

95.5% of households in Newport Pagnell South had all adults in the households with English as their first language and 97.7% had at least one adult with English as their first language.

7. Religion

58.0% of the Newport Pagnell South population stated they were Christian, 0.6% Muslim and 0.5% Hindu. 33% of the population in Newport Pagnell South stated they had no religion.

Table 7 shows the number of people in each religious group in Newport Pagnell South compared with Milton Keynes. It outlines that the largest religious group in Milton Keynes was Christian which accounted for 58% of the population, this is a higher percentage than Milton Keynes as a whole (52.8%).

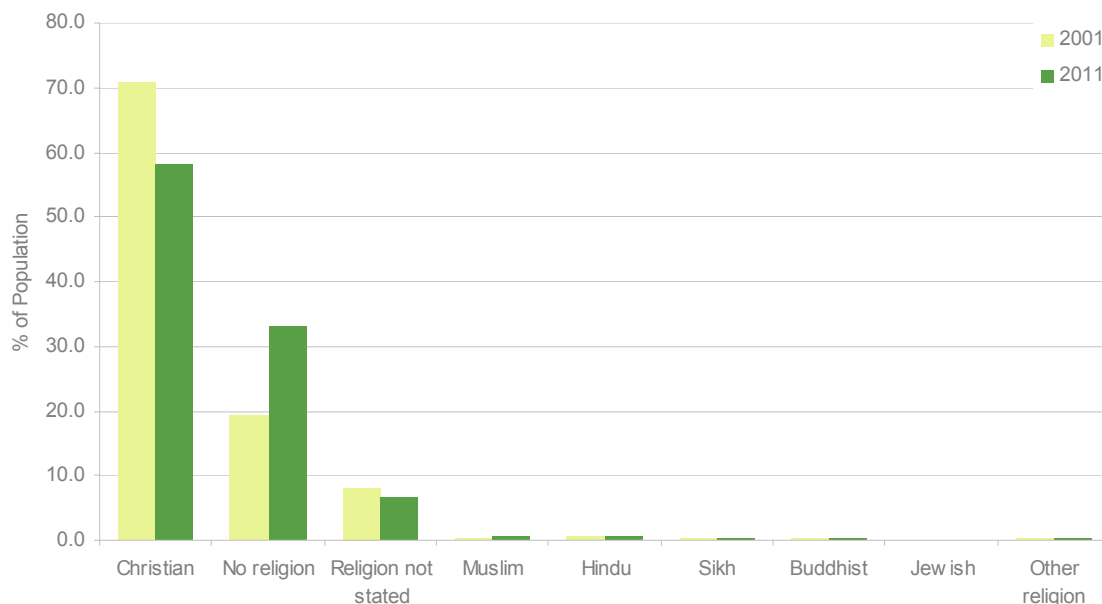

Religions other than Christian were in small proportions in Newport Pagnell South. Muslim is the second largest religion with just 50 people (0.6%)

Graph 4 outlines the changes in religion in Newport Pagnell South between 2001 and 2011. It shows that there was a decline in the percentage of the population that stated they were Christian (70.8% to 58%) and an increase in the percentage that stated they had no religion (19.2% to 33%). There was been no major change in the other religions.

8. Health

5.8% of residents in Newport Pagnell South said their day to day activities were limited a lot because of health issues. This compares to 6.4% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

The 2011 Census asked two questions on the health of residents. Both questions highlight that a slightly smaller percentage of the population in Newport Pagnell South felt that they had health issues when compared to Milton Keynes.

1. Are your day-to-day activities limited because of a health problem or disability which has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months?

450 people stated their day-to-day activities were limited a lot due to health; this is 5.8% of population compared with 6.4% in Milton Keynes. In total 12.6% of residents in Newport Pagnell South stated they were limited a lot or a little. This compares to 13.9% in Milton Keynes.

2. How is your health in general?

270 respondents in Newport Pagnell South felt their general health was bad or very bad. This is 3.4% of the population compared with 4.1% of the Milton Keynes population. 86.9% of residents in the ward felt they had good or very good health compared with 85.1% in Milton Keynes.

The 2011 Census questions on health were different to the 2001 Census and therefore can not be directly compared.

Health status is very strongly correlated to age. Residents in the older age groups tend to be less healthy than younger age groups. Therefore to make robust comparisons between areas health by age is needed.

9. Carers

700 residents in Newport Pagnell South provided some unpaid care a week. This is 9.1% of the population compared with 8.8% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

The 2011 Census asked respondents if they provided some unpaid care each week to others either because of a long term disability or old age. The results show that around 700 people in Newport Pagnell South provided some unpaid care. This is 9.1% of the population, similar to the Milton Keynes figure of 8.8%.

Table 10 shows the number of hours of unpaid care residents undertook each week. It outlines that around 200 people undertook more than 20 hours of unpaid care each week with 110 of those undertaking more than 50 hours.

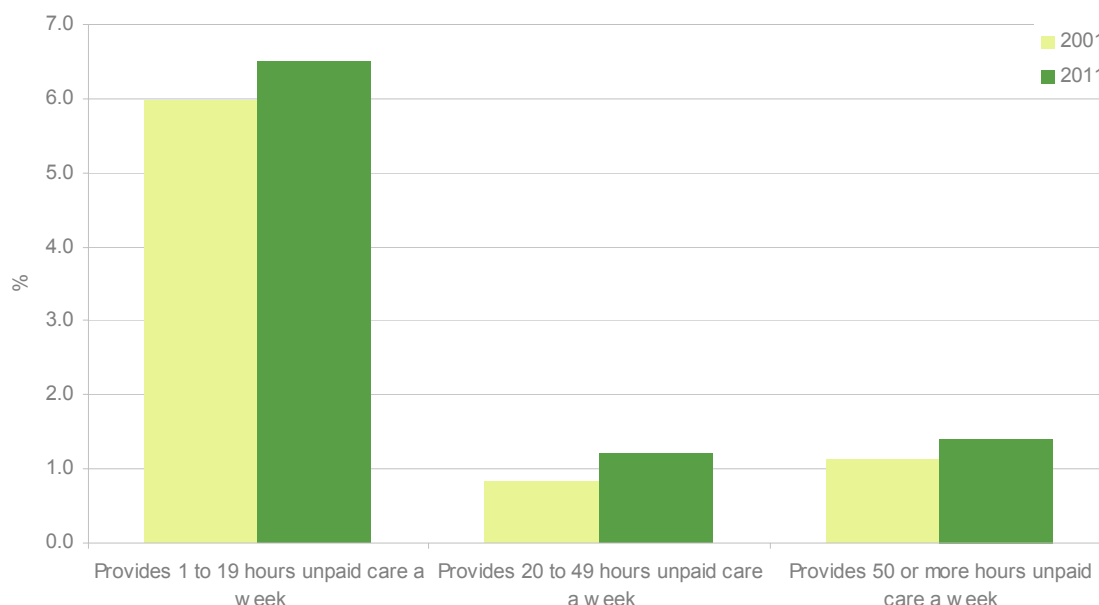

The number of Newport Pagnell South residents providing unpaid care increased by 120 people (21%) between 2001 and 2011.

The number of Newport Pagnell South residents providing unpaid care grew from 580 in 2001 to 700 in 2011. As a percentage of the Milton Keynes population it increased slightly from 8.0% in 2001 to 9.1% in 2011.

Graph 5 outlines that those that were providing unpaid care were doing so with greater hours. 2.6% of the population provided unpaid care for 20 or more hours a week compared with 2.0% in 2001.

10. Living Arrangements

Newport Pagnell South had a higher percentage of people living as a couple than Milton Keynes as a whole.

3,960 residents aged 16 and over in Newport Pagnell South were living as a couple this is 63.1% and compares to 60.4% for Milton Keynes as a whole. 1,381 (22%) residents were single (never married) whilst 6.9% were divorced.

11. Household Composition

Newport Pagnell South had a lower percentage of households with dependent children than Milton Keynes as a whole.

There were 3,290 households in Newport Pagnell South in 2011. 370 (11.1%) of these households were one person pensioner household, this compares to 8.7% for Milton Keynes as a whole. In total 27.9% of households in the ward were one person households compared with 25.9% for Milton Keynes.

In total 980 (29.9%) households in Newport Pagnell South had dependent children this compares to 35.0% in Milton Keynes.

195 households, or 5.9%, in Newport Pagnell South were lone parent households with dependent children. This compares to 8.3% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

The percentage of households with dependent children in Newport Pagnell South declined from 33.8% in 2001 to 29.9% in 2011.

Table 13 outlines how household composition changed between 2001 and 2011. The number of households with dependent children fell slightly from 1,010 to 980; this is a fall from 33.8% of households to 29.9%.

12. Rooms and Bedrooms

Newport Pagnell South had a relatively low average household size. It had an average of 2.3 people per household compared with 2.5 in Milton Keynes.

The Newport Pagnell average household size of 2.3 was the 2nd lowest of all 23 wards in Milton Keynes. There was a decrease in the average household size in the ward between 2001 and 2011 from 2.4 in 2001 to 2.3 in 2011.

Newport Pagnell South had the same number of rooms per household as Milton Keynes. There was an average of 2.8 bedrooms per household and 5.5 rooms per household in Newport Pagnell South.

80 households in Newport Pagnell South lived in over occupied accommodation.

The 2011 Census also estimates the number of households with a high occupancy rating. An occupancy rating of -1 implies that a household had one less room/bedroom than required. Table 15 shows that Newport Pagnell South had around 80 households (2.3%) which were over occupied in terms of bedrooms. This is lower than the Milton Keynes figure of 5.1%.

Over occupancy in terms of rooms increased between 2001 and 2011. In 2001 125 (4.2%) households had an occupancy rating of -1 or less, in 2011 it had risen to 170 (5.1%). This is a trend that is seen nationally.

13. Accommodation Type

A smaller percentage of dwellings were classified as flats in Newport Pagnell South than Milton Keynes as a whole.

There were 3,390 dwellings in Newport Pagnell South in 2011. The 2011 Census asked residents what type of dwelling they lived in. A smaller percentage (12.2%) of dwellings in the ward were flats compared with Milton Keynes (16.2%).

Newport Pagnell South had a larger percentage of terraced houses/bungalows than Milton Keynes as a whole (31.8% compared to 27.4%). The ward also had a larger percentage of semi-detached properties (29.7% compared to 28.1%).

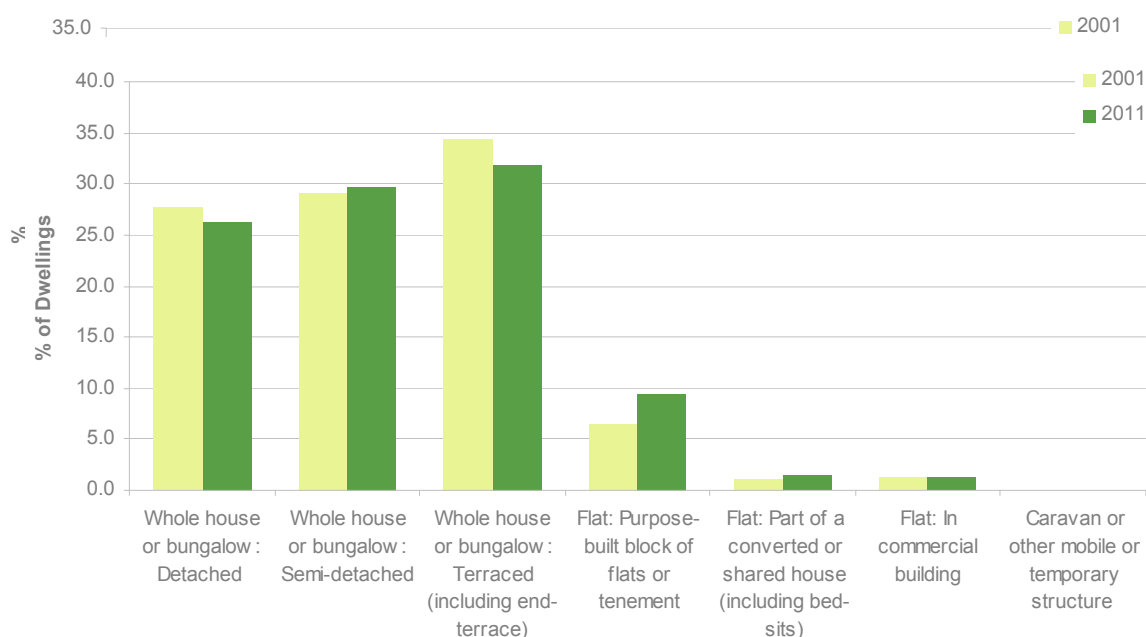
A growing percentage of dwellings in Newport Pagnell South were flats. Just 8.9% of dwellings in the ward were flats in 2001, this compares to 12.2% in 2011.

Overall the number of dwellings in Newport Pagnell South grew from 3,055 in 2001 to 3,390 in 2011. This is an increase of 340 dwellings or 11%.

The number of flats in Newport Pagnell South grew from 270 in 2001 to 415 in 2011. Graph 6 outlines that the percentage of dwelling which were flats increased from 8.9% in 2001 to 12.2% in 2011; this is a trend which is observed nationally.

The number of houses/bungalows in Milton Keynes increased from 2,780 in 2001 to 2,980 in 2011. However they declined in percentage from 91.1% of all dwellings to 87.8%.

14. Tenure

Newport Pagnell South had a significantly higher percentage of owner occupied households and a smaller percentage living in social rented accommodation than Milton Keynes as a whole.

74.7% of dwellings in Newport Pagnell South were owner occupied; this is significantly higher than the figure for Milton Keynes as a whole of 57.7%.

A smaller percentage of households were living in council rented accommodation in Newport Pagnell South than Milton Keynes. 130 households (3.8%) live in council rented accommodation compared to 11.0% in Milton Keynes.

Newport Pagnell also had a lower percentage of households in other social rented accommodation than Milton Keynes. There were just 40 households in social rented housing other than from the council accounting for 1.3% of households compared with 7.1% in Milton Keynes. 600 households were in private rented accommodation (including living rent free); this is 18.3% of the population.

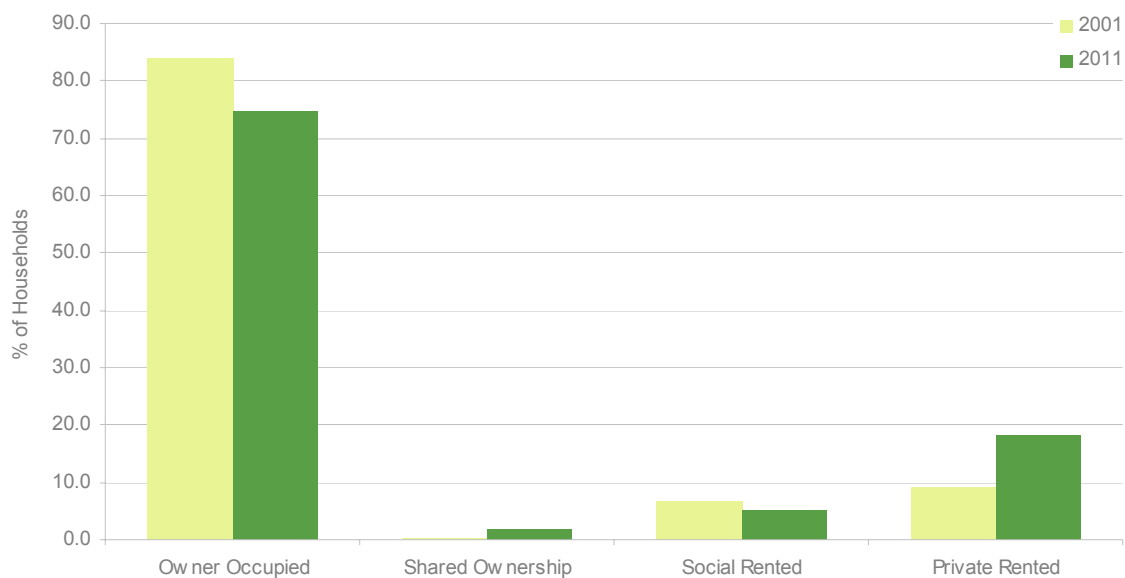
The percentage of households living in private rented accommodation in Newport Pagnell South increased from 9.2% in 2001 to 18.3% in 2011.

In 2001 275 households in Newport Pagnell South were living in private rented accommodation by 2011 it had increased to 600. It increased from 9.2% of all households in 2001 to 18.3% in 2011.

The number of households living in social rented accommodation declined slightly from 200 in 2001 to 170 in 2011. As a percentage of all dwellings it decreased from 6.6% to 5.2%.

There was a large decrease in the percentage of households living in owner occupied properties in Newport Pagnell South from 83.9% in 2001 to 74.7% in 2011. The percentage of households in shared ownership increased from 0.4% to 1.8%.

16. Car or Van Availability

There were 560 more cars or vans in Newport Pagnell South in 2011 compared with 2001. This is a 13.9% increase compared to the population growth of 6%.

In total in 2011 there were 4,610 cars or vans in households in Newport Pagnell South compared with 4,050 in 2001. However 500 households in the ward had no car or van. This is 15.1% of all households, significantly lower than Milton Keynes (18.9%).

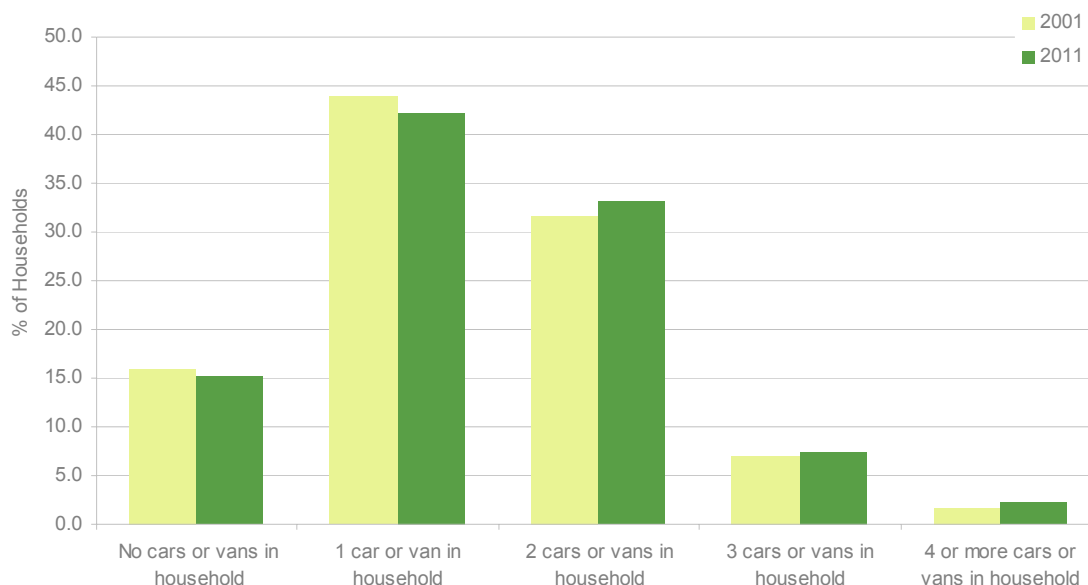

There was an average of 1.4 cars per household in Newport Pagnell South compared to 1.3 cars per household in Milton Keynes.

Graph 8 outlines that between 2001 and 2011 the percentage of households with no or one car/van declined slightly whilst the percentage of households with 2 or more cars/vans increased.

18. Qualifications and Students

Levels of qualifications in Newport Pagnell South were higher than the Milton Keynes average. 30.2% had a degree and higher compared with 28.2% in Milton Keynes. 15.4% had no qualifications compared with 18.0% in Milton Keynes.

Table 20 shows the highest level of qualifications for residents aged 16+. It outlines that roughly 970 people aged 16+ in Newport Pagnell South had no qualifications. This is 15.4% of the population and is significantly lower than the Milton Keynes average of 18.0%.

1,900 people aged 16+ in the ward had a degree or higher qualification. This is 30.2% of the population, higher than the Milton Keynes average of 28.2%.

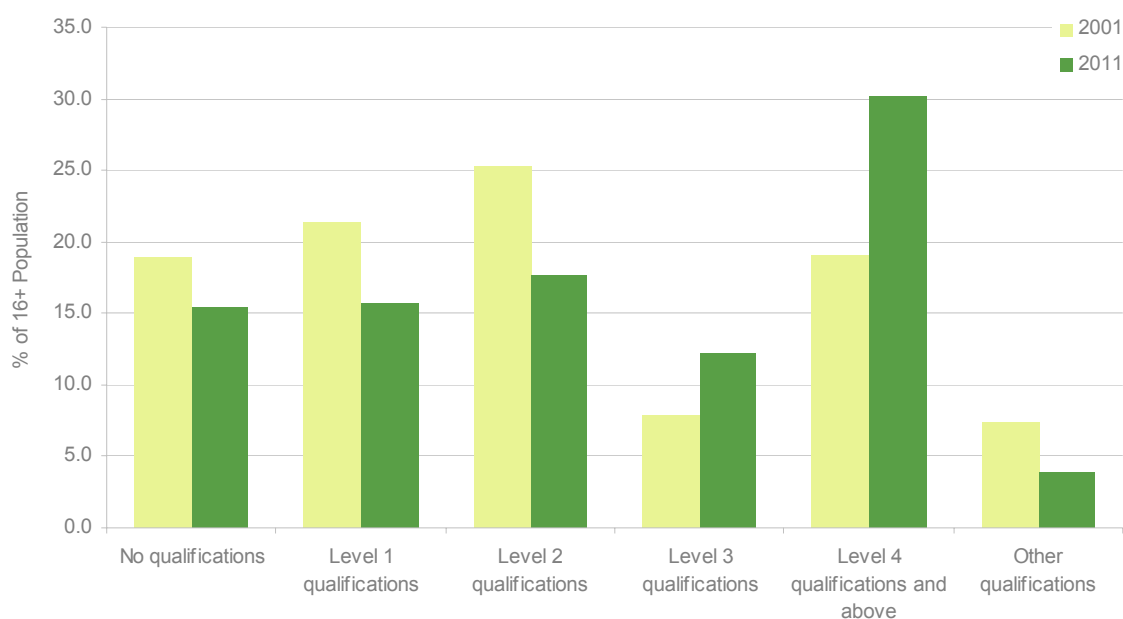

Levels of qualifications in Newport Pagnell South increased significantly between 2001 and 2011.

In addition to qualifications being higher than Milton Keynes, levels of qualifications increased considerably between 2001 and 2011. Graph 9 outlines how levels of qualifications changed since 2001. In 2001 19.1% of residents aged 16+ had a degree or higher, by 2011 this had increased to 30.2%. In 2001 18.9% of the population had no qualifications by 2011 this had decreased to 15.4%.

Newport Pagnell South had a smaller percentage of students aged 18+ than Milton Keynes.

Table 21 shows that there were 160 people aged 18 and over in full time education resident in the ward. This is 2.5% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes average of 3.5%.

19. Economic Activity

A higher percentage (73.2%) of Newport Pagnell South residents aged 16-74 were in employment compared with Milton Keynes (68%).

Table 22 outlines that the population aged 16-74 can be broken down into two broad categories:

1. Economically Active: People that were in work or looking and available for work.

4,630 people in the Newport Pagnell South were economically active. This is 79.2% of the 16-74 year old population which is significantly higher than the Milton Keynes figure of 75.9%. The reason why Newport Pagnell South had a higher economic activity rate is the high percentage of the population in employment. 4,280 residents in the ward were in employment, this is 73.2% of the 16-74 year old population significantly higher than the Milton Keynes average of 68.0%. 560 residents (9.6%) in Milton Keynes were self employed; this is a larger percentage than the Milton Keynes average (8.7%).

There were 200 unemployed people in Newport Pagnell South which accounted for 3.4% of the population, lower than the Milton Keynes rate of 4.8%.

2. Economically Inactive: People that were not in work and were not looking and available for work.

Newport Pagnell South had a smaller percentage of the 16-74 population who were economically inactive. 20.8% of the ward's 16-74 population were economically inactive compared with 24.1% in Milton Keynes as a whole. This is due to four main factors.

1. A smaller percentage of the 16-74 year old population were looking after home or family (2.9% in Newport Pagnell South, 4.6% in Milton Keynes).
2. A smaller percentage of the 16-74 year old population were long-term sick or disabled. (2.1% in Newport Pagnell South, 3.2% in Milton Keynes).
3. A smaller percentage of the 16-74 year old population were students not in or looking for work (3.2% in Newport Pagnell South, 3.9% in Milton Keynes).
4. A smaller percentage of the 16-74 year old population were economically inactive for other reasons (1.2% in Newport Pagnell South, 2.1% in Milton Keynes).

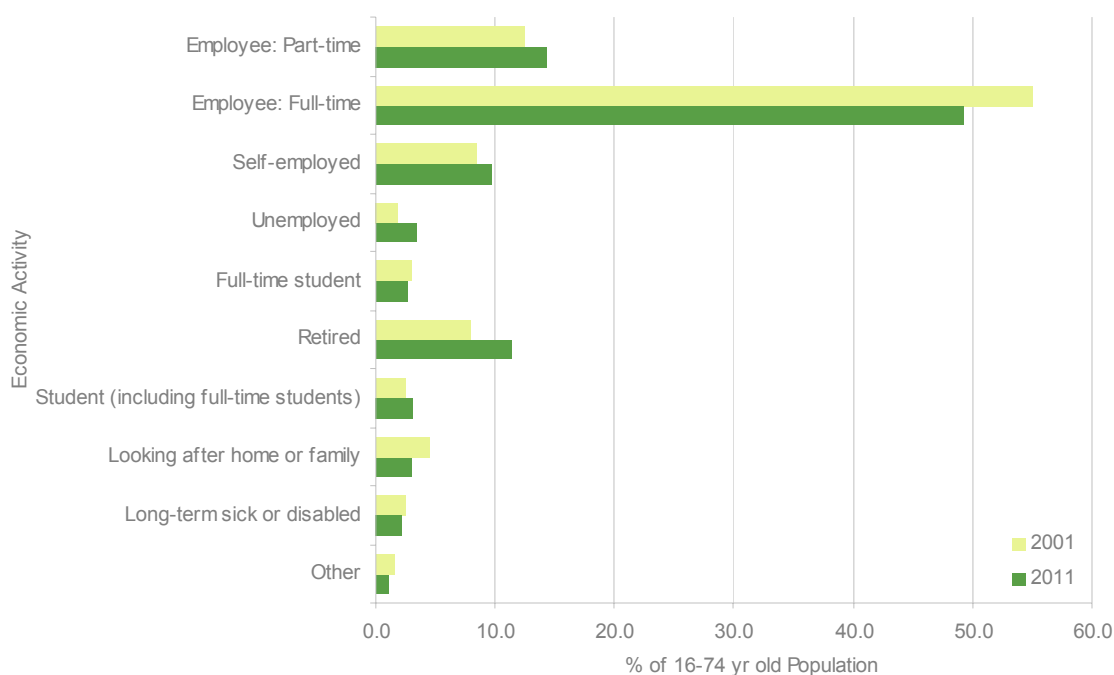

There was a fall in the percentage of 16-74 year old population working as full time employees in Newport Pagnell South.

Graph 10 outlines that the percentage of the 16-74 population employed as full time employees decreased from 55% in 2001 to 49.2% in 2011. However, there was an increase in the percentage of people in part time employment and self employment. This is a trend experienced nationally.

The percentage of people who were unemployed increased from 1.9% to 3.4%, whilst the percentage of people who were retired also increased between 2001 and 2011.

Economic activity is strongly correlated to age. Middle aged people tend to be more economically active than younger people (who may be students) and older people (who were more likely to be retired etc). Therefore to make robust comparisons between areas economic activity by age is needed.

20. Hours Worked

Three quarters of Newport Pagnell South residents in employment worked full time hours whilst a quarter worked part time.

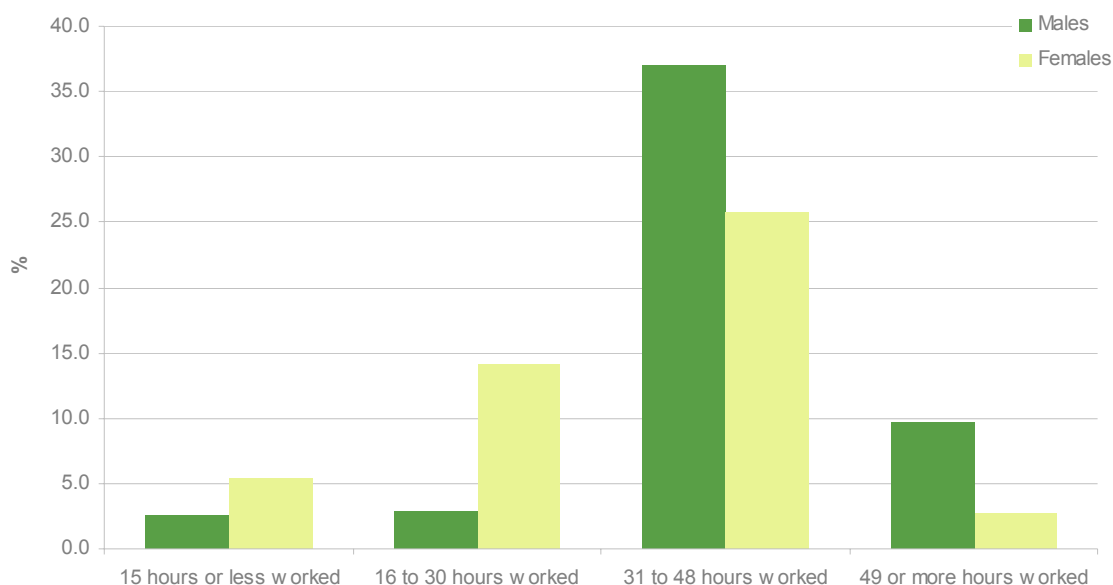
The 2011 Census asked those in employment how many hours they worked a week. Table 23 outlines that in total 1,100 the ward’s residents worked part time hours this is 24.9%.

21. Industry

83.6% of Newport Pagnell South residents in employment were employed in the service sector compared with 85.3% in Milton Keynes as a whole.

3,680 Newport Pagnell South residents were employed in the service sector. This is 83.6% of employment compared with 85.3% in Milton Keynes as a whole. 350 Newport Pagnell South residents in employment were employed in the manufacturing sector; this is 7.9% of those in employment. A larger percentage of residents were employed in 'other' industries such as construction in the ward compared with Milton Keynes.

The wholesale and retail trade industrial sector is the largest employer of Newport Pagnell South residents.

Table 24 provides more detail on the industry of employment in Newport Pagnell South and Milton Keynes. It shows that the wholesale and retail trade is the largest employer of residents in the ward. 810 residents were employed in this

sector; this is 18.4% of people in employment compared with 20.6% in Milton Keynes. Education, health and social work and public administration, defence and compulsory social security employs 1,195 people (27.1%).

The education, construction, Public administration and defence; compulsory social security, other, and real estate activities sectors in were larger in Newport Pagnell South than Milton Keynes as a whole. The wholesale, transport and storage and Administrative and support service activities were in smaller proportions compared with Milton Keynes.

22. Occupation

10.8% of residents in the ward were employed in manager, director and senior official occupations and 9.2% in elementary occupations.

The same percentage of employees were employed in the managerial occupations in Newport Pagnell South compared with Milton Keynes as a whole. 400 residents were employed in elementary occupations. This is 9.2% of those in employment and is lower than the Milton Keynes average of 12.3%.

A smaller percentage of people in employment in Newport Pagnell were employed in sales and customer service occupations and process, plant and machine operative occupations than Milton Keynes as a whole. Larger proportions were

employed in associate professional and technical occupations, administrative and secretarial occupations and skilled trades occupations.

The largest increase in employment between 2001 and 2011 in Newport Pagnell South occurred in professional occupations the largest decrease occurred in managers, directors and senior officials.

Graph 12 outlines that the largest increase in employment between 2001 and 2011 in Newport Pagnell South occurred in professional occupations. 10.8% of those in employment in 2001 were employed in professional occupations by 2011 this increased to 18.4%. There was also a large increase in caring, leisure and other service occupations – from 5.5% to 7.8%. The largest decrease occurred in managers, directors and senior officials from 16.6% to 10.8%.

23. National Statistics – Socio-Economic Classification

Residents in Newport Pagnell South were more likely to be classified in managerial and intermediate socio-economic categories than Milton Keynes as a whole.

730 residents aged 16-74 in the ward were in the higher managerial and professional category. This is 12.5% of the population compared with 12.2% in Milton Keynes. Newport Pagnell South also had a higher percentage of people in the lower managerial, administrative and professional occupations, intermediate occupations and the small employers and own account workers categories.

Newport Pagnell South had a smaller percentage of residents in semi-routine and routine occupations than Milton Keynes as a whole.
