

Burglary Offences Over Time

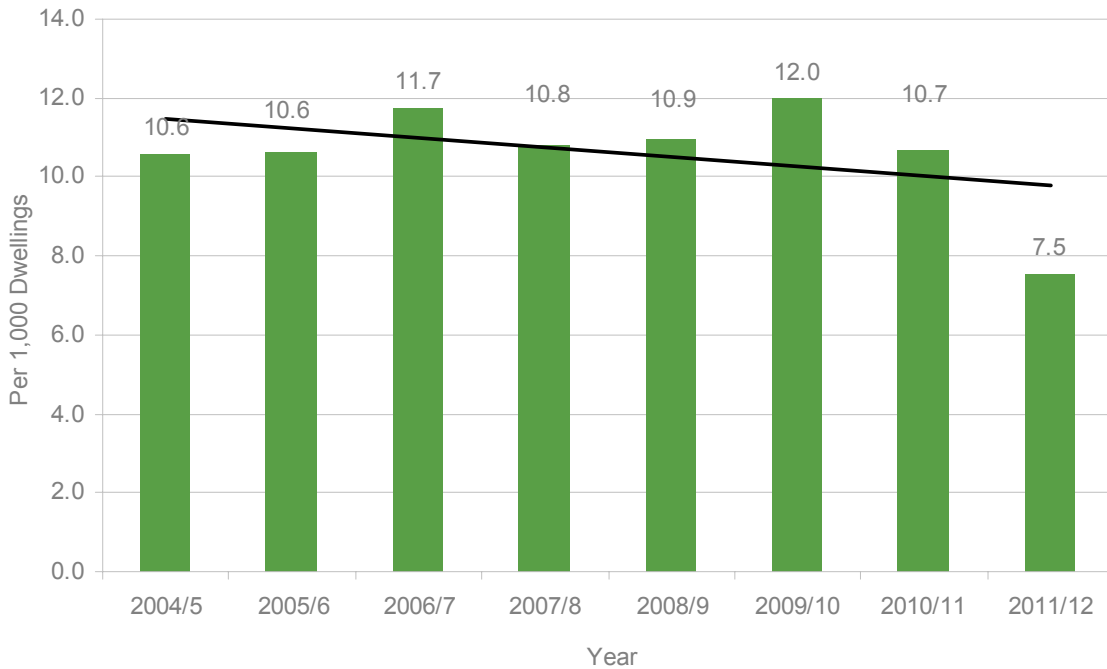
This report analyses burglary offences data provided for the production of the Social Atlas between 2004/5 and 2011/12.

Borough level data over time

The number of burglaries of dwellings in Milton Keynes increased from 965 in 2004/5 to 785 in 2011/12; this is an 18.7% decrease.

Looking at the rate per 1,000 dwellings (to adjust for the growth in numbers because of the population growth) the trend in burglary offences was relatively flat between 2004/5 and 2010/11. Then there was a large decrease in 2011/12, the rate fell from 10.7 in 2010/11 to 7.5 in 2011/12.

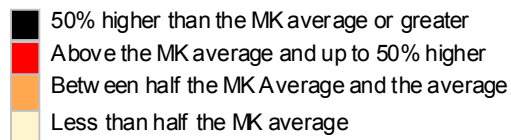
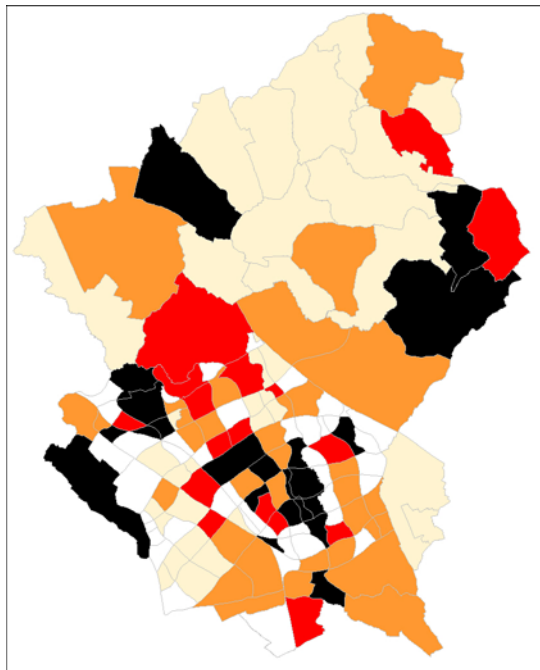
Chart 1: Rate of burglary offences over time, Milton Keynes borough average per 1,000 dwellings



Estate and Settlement level over time

The pattern of burglary crimes is not uniform across the borough. Some estates have significantly above average proportions of crimes. Maps 1 and 2 show the rates per 1,000 dwellings for estates in 2004/5 and 2011/12. They outline that between 2004/5 and 2011/12 different estates show up as having high rates of burglaries.

Map 2: Rate of burglary crimes 2011/12

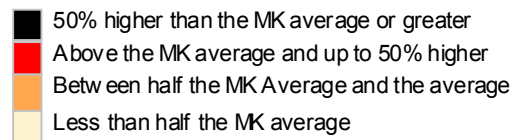
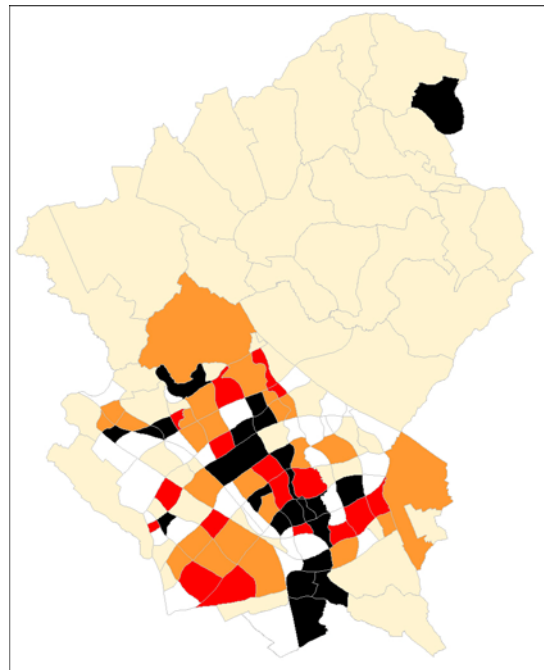


Table 1 shows the top ten estates between 2004/5 and 2011/12. It outlines that relatively few estates consistently appear in the top ten. Granby appears in the top seven between 2004/5 and 2007/8. Netherfield appears in the top ten in six of the eight years.
