Census Atlas: Ethnic Group

Introduction

This document provides a set of thematic maps on the **ethnic group** data by estate and settlement in Milton Keynes from 2011 Census data.

Methodology

These maps were created by the Research and Intelligence team at Milton Keynes Council based on 2011 Census data published by the Office for National Statistics.

The 2011 Census data was not released at estate level. The Research and Intelligence team at Milton Keynes Council therefore added together Output Area (the smallest census geography) data to provide an estimate at estate level. As Output Areas (OAs) boundaries and estate boundaries do not always match, the data for OAs is weighted to estates. The data in the maps should therefore be seen as estimates based on 2011 Census data rather than actual figures. 


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Map 1: % White British




Rural Areas have the highest percentage of White British residents. All of the rural areas have more than 87% of residents stating they are White British. The highest percentages are found in Stoke Goldington (96.0%), Ravenstone (95.7%) and Little Brickhill (95.3%).






Central Milton Keynes has the highest percentage (16.8%) of Other White residents. Other estates which have a higher percentage include Peartree Bridge (12.0%), Campbell Park (11.5%), Granby (10.5%), Conniburrow (10.4%) and Broughton & Atterbury (10.0%).

Map 3: Mixed / Multiple Ethnic Groups




The mixed ethnic group is well spread across the urban area. 36 estates have more than 3.7% of residents in this group. The estates with the highest percentages include Grange Farm (6.0%), Westcroft (5.7%), Wolverton Mill (5.6%), Leadenhall (5.4%) and Oxley Park (5.3%).

Map 4: % Asian / Asian British: Indian



The highest proportions of residents classifying themselves as Indian occur in areas to the west of the city centre including Central Milton Keynes. Estates with the highest percentages include Oakhill (13.7%), Central Milton Keynes (12.4%), Shenley Church End (9.6%), Oldbrook (8.9%), Loughton Lodge (8.4%) and Two Mile Ash (8.0%).

Map 5: % Asian / Asian British: Pakistani



Residents classifying themselves as Pakistani are concentrated around the Wolverton area. 9.2% of residents in Wolverton estate are Pakistani. Other areas with a high percentage include Stacey Bushes (8.6%), Hodge Lea (6.7%), Galley Hill (4.5%) and Greenleys (4.4%).

Residents classifying themselves as Bangladeshi are concentrated around the Central Bletchley area. 12.2% of residents in Central Bletchley estate are Bangladeshi. Other areas with a high percentage include Water Eaton (4.9%), Fenny Stratford (3.6%) Hodge Lea (2.6%). Just 9 estates have more than 1% of residents stating they are Bangladeshi.



Estates with the highest proportion of Chinese residents include Loughton Lodge (3.6%), Central Milton Keynes (3.1%), Kents Hill (3.0%), Granby (2.9%) and Willen (2.8%).



Map 8: Asian / Asian British: Other




Other Asian residents appear in relatively large proportions in a number of estates towards the centre of the urban area. Estates with the highest percentages include Eaglestone (9.9%), Oldbrook (9.6%), Springfield (8.3%), Downs Barn (7.9%) and Leadenhall (7.1%).

Map 9: Black / Black British: African




Almost a quarter (24.5%) of residents in Fishermead are Black African. Other estates with high percentages include Granby (22.9%), Conniburrow (18.5%), Netherfield (18.1%), Oakhill (14.2%) and Broughton & Atterbury (14.2%).




The Black Caribbean ethnic group is relatively evenly spread across the urban area. Just four estates have more than 2% of residents in this group. Those estates are Western Expansion Area/Calverton Parish (2.7%), Ashland (2.6%), Leadenhall (2.4%) and Medbourne (2.1%).

Other Black residents appear in relatively small percentages in most estates in Milton Keynes. Estates with the highest percentages include Granby (2.9%), Wolverton Mill (2.4%), Fishermead (2.4%) and Conniburrow (2.0%).

Other Ethnic Group residents appear in relatively small percentages in most estates in Milton Keynes. Estates with the highest percentages include Oakhill (2.4%), Ashland (2.0%), Medbourne (1.8%), and Grange Farm (1.7%).
