New Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) 2015 – Coming soon

The Index of Multiple Deprivation provides a relative measure of deprivation in small areas across England. The Index of Multiple Deprivation is based on the concept that deprivation consists of more than just poverty. Public Sector Employment Q2 2015, ONS

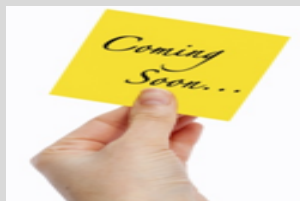
This release contains detailed public sector employment estimates, updated quarterly. The public sector comprises central government, local government and public corporations.
