# **Unemployment** and Jobs Update

- ► In November 2015 unemployment (claimant count) went down to 2,316 claimants in Milton Keynes (1.4%) of the working age population from 2,550 (1.5%) in October 2015.
- ► The tendency shows that the highest total of claimant count is usually around February-March, and the lowest total of claimant count is in December.

#### **New Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) 2015**

The Index of Multiple Deprivation provides a relative measure of deprivation in small areas across England. The Index of Multiple Deprivation is based on the concept that deprivation consists of more than just poverty.

The 2015 Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) was published in September 2015 by the Social Disadvantage Research Centre at the University of Oxford for the Department of Communities and Local Government.

Milton Keynes returned a score of 18.03 which is ranked 181 out of 326 (with 1 being the most deprived). This compares to the 2010 rank of 211.
